#### **Business Situation**

This client of ours had an idea to develop a portal for neonatal nurses to collaborate among themselves as well as other healthcare providers both nationally and internationally to gather and share information regarding healthcare decision making, policy development and care of newborns. The portal was also meant for promoting knowledge translation for effective and innovative approach to neonatal nursing practice and changes in health policy. Registered users would be allowed to share knowledge, experiences and ideas with other health care providers both nationally and internationally. The idea was to develop two different zones, one for the admin for administrative tasks and & content management on different pages and the later used by the external users (nurses).

Beyond the basic specifications sent by the client, he had some other additional features to be incorporated while developing the portal. The tasks were plenty and the time period was less yet, Mindfire's offshore SharePoint team took the challenge of developing the portal using SharePoint 2007 and delivered it within the time frame discussed.

# Solution Details The Mindfire Solution

Mindfire's offshore SharePoint team with their immense expertise and dedication developed a complete portal for the client catering every single requirement of his. The final portal developed consisted of two different zones as demanded by the client.

- 1. **Intranet -** Used only by the admin for all the administrative tasks.
- 2. **Internet** Used by the external users i.e. nurses. This is based on the Form Based Authentication driven through SQL Membership Provider.

Mindfire's offshore team was completely involved in the creation of the whole portal with the internet zone having various sub-pages linked to the welcome page. These pages include Home Page, About Us, Membership, SIG, Event, Partnership and Contact Us. There were also other additional pages developed like Member Registration page, Member Log-in page, Member Landing page, My Profile page and many more. Some pages were developed which gets appended for privileged users like Board of Directors, Conference Committee, Education Committee, Executive Committee, Nutrition, Developmental Care etc.

The intranet zone only allows access to admin. The internal site contains document libraries, lists, picture libraries, discussion boards, surveys, sites, people and groups, manage members, view membership requests etc. Only the admin has the power to add/edit items within the intranet site.

The portal also exposes some generic and basic information for the anonymous users like Recent News, Upcoming Events, etc. Any anonymous user can request for membership and upon approval by admin is provided with a username and password to login into the site and take privilege of the additional features like Members Directory, Polls, Discussion Board, Announcements, Important Links, Blogs, Newsletter, Document sharing & downloading through different libraries etc. The admin can also elect the registered nurses as Board of Director for a specific year and also grant privileges to few other collaborative sub-sites within it. The system is capable of sending out different types of notification e-mails based on different date checks through timer jobs running in the background. Also, a payment gateway has been integrated within the site for credit card processing during registration and renew of membership.

Thus, Mindfire has delivered the client with two different robust and efficient sites that can handle every request made by the admin or an external user smoothly.

#### **Achievements**




